

Notes

There will be further engagement and investigation as part of the detailed design of the three hubs.

This additional work includes:

- Cultural heritage assessments.
- Traffic engineering assessments, to review and confirm road and carpark requirements.
- Tree and vegetation assessments, to guide the final location and layout of new design features.
- Access and inclusion assessments.
- Identification of Djaara artist opportunities, including commissioned artworks, signage and interpretive elements.
- Planting design, using indigenous species and plants of significance to Dja Dja Wurrung.
- Detailed design of furniture and park infrastructure.
